## Updates regarding CAH's activities as Ontario enters step 3 of reopening

On July 16th 2021, the province of Ontario entered into its step 3 of reopening, bringing with it some changes to certain activities at CAH.

We are very happy to share these changes, which will allow us to be more connected socially and restart certain activities – doing both in larger groups.

### Dining Room

With the guidance of the government of Ontario, we can now welcome a maximum of 25 people in the dining room. We will have 12 tables where people from the same household can dine at the same table. The tables must maintain a distance of 2m from one another.

Please make sure you wait to be served – we request that you do not serve yourself from behind the counter.

Please note that it is necessary to make a reservation to be able to dine in the dining room.

Information about reservations is posted on the bulletin board.

Please remember to wear your mask and to wash and disinfect your hands!

### Reminders

- You must always wear your mask
- It is important to wash and disinfect your hands in a consistent and thorough manner
- The hairdresser will be at CAH every Thursday; she will be seeing one person at a time. You can make a reservation with Ayda. Please ensure that you wear your mask!
